## COVID-19 UPDATE

With the latest COVID-19 outbreak in NSW, restrictions have been reinstated for Aged Care Facilities.

From 5:00pm today (6<sup>th</sup> May 2021) the following restrictions will be enforced.

- All staff and visitors must wear a surgical mask at all times.
- All staff and visitors are to sign in or login using the QR Code.
- All staff and visitors are to have their temperature taken on arrival.
- Aged Care Residents of JMV North Sydney may only have one visitor at a time in their room.
- Aged Care Residents of JMV Woolwich may only have two visitors at a time in their room.
- Visits are permitted in outdoor communal space (with correct social distancing in place).
- Each resident may have a maximum of two visitors per day. They may have different visitors each day.
- Residents going out of the village must wear a surgical mask at all times.

There is a new list of current HOTSPOTS at JMV Receptions. If you have been to any of these locations during the last week, you are not permitted to enter the village and should return home to isolate.

Both JMV North Sydney and Woolwich have COVID-19 vaccinations scheduled for tomorrow (Friday 7<sup>th</sup> May 2021). These vaccinations will proceed as scheduled with the necessary precautions taken by staff.

We are still proceeding with our Mother's Day events tomorrow. Residents only are permitted to attend, and social distancing will be in place.
